

Ladies and gentlemen,
We will now present the safety instructions and emergency equipment of our aircraft. Hand luggage should be placed in overhead compartments or under the seat in front of you. We will now demonstrate how to fasten, adjust, and unfasten your seatbelt.

Please ensure that your tray tables are stowed, your seatbacks are in the upright position, and armrests are lowered for takeoff and landing. All windows must be uncovered.

If cabin pressure suddenly drops, oxygen masks will automatically drop down from above your head. Remain seated, grab the nearest mask, and pull it toward you to activate the oxygen flow. Place the mask over your nose and mouth, secure the elastic band behind your head, and breathe normally.

Our aircraft is equipped with eight emergency exits, clearly marked with the word "EXIT". Four exits are located through doors at the front of the cabin, and four through doors at the rear of the cabin.

Please note that the nearest exit may be behind you. In an emergency situation, the floor lighting system will guide you to the exit.

There is a strict no-smoking policy on board, and there are smoke detectors in the restrooms.

Please follow the crew's instructions.
